SS (sustainable sites)

To reduce the influence of the heat island effect on the microclimate and natural habitats to the absolute minimum.

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The light-colored tiles of the Audrey Lane range, used in outdoor areas, help reduce the heat island effect (the thermal gradient difference between urban and suburban areas) to minimize the impact on the microclimate.
